SITUATION ANALYSIS

The history of San Mateo County Community College dates back to 1922 when its downtown San Mateo campus opened the doors to 35 students. The College has grown significantly over the years and now operates three separate colleges that collectively serve more than 40,000 students throughout San Mateo County. With growth has come heightened safety, security concerns and new requirements.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To implement an AMAG Global Security Platform standard to the District while meeting the ever-changing safety and security requirements associated with higher-education environments.
- To work with the design and construction team on implementing a customized security solution to most effectively protect the faculty, students and the facilities they occupy across the District's three campuses on the San Francisco Peninsula: College of San Mateo, Skyline College and Canada College.

PROJECT SCOPE

The protection of people and assets amid an ever-changing academic world is an ongoing objective of The San Mateo Community College District. SMCCD hired security consultant TEECOM to conduct a thorough analysis of each college's specific requirements and spearhead the design and implementation of a District-wide security system.
